Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival at Paris

on Arrival at Paris Air Port meet your driver at arrival hall and Proceed to hotel , check in to Hotel , Over night at Paris hotel

Day 2: Eiffel Tower visit + Pass City Tour + Seine cruise

After breakfast at Hotel, later Discover Paris, with a double decker-bus including: translucent roof, retractable windows with individual audio guides During this original visit, you will discover the main 40 tourist sites and monuments in Paris : from the Louvre to the Tour Eiffel going by the Champs-Élysées and Arc de Triomphe, Notre-Dame, Invalides, Pont Alexandre III .An unbelievable moment in Paris! One hour cruise by the river Seine, starting at the foot of the Eiffel Tower. Discover the best of Paris in a 1 hour sightseeing cruise in the heart of Paris. The crew member will be pleased to welcome you for an unbelievable moment. Starting at the centre of Paris, you will discover the most beautiful monuments of the city: Louvre, Orsay, and Notre-Dame... During this boat trip, you will also see quaysides, bridges and banks which liven up the Parisian life. Over night at Paris Hotel

Day 3: Paris to Zurich By Train

Breakfast at hotel - later check out and proceed to Train Station with Pick up from Hotel , Board Train to Zurich - on Arrival at Zurich station you will be pick by private car and proceed to hotel , check in to Hotel , Over night at zurich hotel

Day 4: Mt Titlis - Eternal Snow and Glaciers at 3020m

Breakfast at Hotel - later proceed to Excursion to Mount Titlis – at 3020 m / 10'000 ft. From Lucerne the train takes you to the mountain monastery village Engelberg where you board a gondola which takes you up to the Trübsee. You continue your trip by another gondola to Stand and finally the first revolving Titlis Rotair cable car takes you up to Mount Titlis. For a spectacular, close-up insight into a glacier, visit the glacier cave and ride the Ice Flyer chairlift. And get your thrills on the TITLIS Cliff Walk, a spectacular Suspension bridge at a height of 3041 m/10'000 ft. Overnight : in Zurich Hotel

Day 5: Zurich City Tour and Surrounding

Breakfast at Hotel , later proceed to Zurich City Tour and Surrounding Discover culture, nature and the lake of Zurich and its region with the city tour followed by a short cable car ride and a crossing of the lake by ferry. For those who wish to combine culture with nature. We show you the main sights of Zurich: the Old Town, the biggest clock-face of Europe on St. Peter's church, the world-famous Bahnhofstrasse, the Limmatquai, the Guild Houses, including in depth description of the famous Chagall stained glass Windows at Fraumuenster-Church. The City Tour includes a short walk through the Old Town. The journey continues to Adliswil for a ride by cable car to Felsenegg (800 metres) where you enjoy beautiful views over Zurich, the lake and the white peaks of the Alps. Day 6: Zurich –Venice by Train

Day 7: Venice Island Tours

After breakfast. Today morning proceed for the Best of Venice tour with St. Marks Square, Rialto Bridge, Bridge of Sighs; enjoy the famous sights of Venice with the entrance to St. Marks Basilica. Later proceed to experience the world famous Gondola Experience. Later return to hotel. Overnight at Venice

Day 8: Venice – Florence by Train

After breakfast. Make your own way to proceed Venice train station. Later board a train to Florence. Upon arrival at Florence, proceed to hotel. You can enjoy the city sightseeing using the 24 hour hop on hop off pass. Discover the city Piazzale Michelangelo, Florence Old Town, Cathedral of Santa Maria dei Fiori, Giotto's bell tower, Academia Gallery and Many More at your own pace with this pass. Overnight at Florence

Day 9: Florence – Pisa Tour– Florence

After breakfast, today proceed for a full day trip to Pisa and Lucca with transfers in Air conditioned coach. Enjoy a tour of the world famous Leaning tower of Pisa and the Lucca guided visit of historical centre where you will have the chance to admire the Anfiteatro Square, the Guinigi Tower, San Martino Dome, Church of San Michele, Clock Tower and the typical antique dealers street. Later enjoy Bucellato, atypical Lucca cake while return to Florence. Overnight at Florence

Day 10: Florence – Rome by Train

Proof of Occupation

Self Employed – Cover letter on company letter head, company registration, partnership, proof of paid tax.

Employed – Work contract, letter from employer (no- objection) confirming leave period & returning back to work, copy of staff id.

Student – Letter from school / College confirming your studies, holiday or leave given to you, copy of Student ID.

Retired – Proof of Retirement / Pension book.

Confirmation of package tour & advance payment proof (if applicable)

Detailed day to day itinerary.

Evidence of Financial Status

Self-Employed: Last 6 months Personal and Business Bank Statements & Property Valuation.

Student & Unemployed: Last 6 months Bank Statement of parents or legal guardian.

Retired: Personal pension bank statement for last 6 months. Proof of regular income generated by ownership of property or business & Property Valuation.

Insurance minimum coverage of 30000 Euros.

Flight Reservation

Round Trip Flight Booking.

Visa & Entry Requirements

Do Nepali citizens need a visa for Europe?

Yes. You'll need a Schengen Visa to visit most European countries.

Which countries are covered by the Schengen Visa?

26 countries including France, Germany, Italy, Spain, Switzerland, and more.

Where do I apply for the visa?

Through VFS Global (Thamel, Kathmandu). Choose the embassy of the country you'll spend the most time in.

How long does visa processing take?

Typically 3–9 working days, but apply at least 1 month in advance

Flights & Travel Tips

Which airlines fly from Nepal to Europe?

Qatar Airways, Turkish Airlines, Emirates, and others via Middle Eastern hubs.

Can I travel between countries freely?

Yes, once inside the Schengen Area, you can move between member countries without border checks.

Can I extend my tourist visa while in Europe?

No, tourist visas cannot be extended while traveling.

What currency is used?

Most countries use the Euro (€), but some (like Switzerland) use their own.

What should I pack?

Warm clothes (Europe can be chilly even in spring)

Power adapter (Europe uses Type C/E/F plugs)

Travel documents + copies

Snacks and Nepali essentials (masala, wai-wai if you miss home!)

Is travel insurance mandatory?


Yes, and it must cover medical emergencies up to €30,000
