Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive at Milan

Arrive in the city of Milan. Later coach transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day will be free to explore the city and the surrounding on own. Overnight in Milan.

Day 2: Milan city tour on SIC

After breakfast, Today proceed for Milan city tour with Skip the line Walk through the historical and artistic area in Milan - Brera Visit Duomo, Galleria Vittorio Emmanuel II and Scala Theatre, chance to look at Leonardo Da Vinci's masterpiece and be amazed by the impressive architecture last Supper AM tour. Later evening free to explore the magical sights of Milan and shopping on own. Overnight at Milan. (B)

Day 3: Milan – Venice by Train

After breakfast . Proceed to Milan station and later board your train to Venice Island. Upon arrival at St. Lucia station, proceed to hotel on own. Check in and rest of the day free for leisure. Overnight at Venice. (B)

Day 4: Venice Island Tours

After breakfast. Today morning proceed for the Best of Venice tour with St. Marks Square, Rialto Bridge, Bridge of Sighs; enjoy the famous sights of Venice with the entrance to St. Marks Basilica. Later proceed to experience the world famous Gondola Experience. Later return to hotel. Overnight at Venice. (B)

Day 5: Venice – Florence by Train

After breakfast. Make your own way to proceed Venice train station. Later board a train to Florence. Upon arrival at Florence, proceed to hotel. You can enjoy the city sightseeing using the 24 hour hop on hop off pass. Discover the city Piazzale Michelangelo, Florence Old Town, Cathedral of Santa Maria dei Fiori, Giotto's bell tower, Academia Gallery and Many More at your own pace with this pass. Overnight at Florence. (B)

Day 6: Florence – Pisa Tour– Florence

After breakfast, today proceed for a full day trip to Pisa and Lucca with transfers in Air conditioned coach. Enjoy a tour of the world famous Leaning tower of Pisa and the Lucca guided visit of historical centre where you will have the chance to admire the Anfiteatro Square, the Guinigi Tower, San Martino Dome, Church of San Michele, Clock Tower and the typical antique dealers street. Later enjoy Bucellato, atypical Lucca cake while return to Florence. Overnight at Florence. (B)

Day 7: Florence – Rome by Train

Visa Application Form.

(In case of Minor) Both parents should sign application form & add a copy of passports.

A Birth certificate & minor identity card must be provided.

Valid passports with 2 blank pages.

2 Passport Size Photos (35*40)

Previous Passports is suggested to be bound together.

Original Visa Cover Letter.

(Letter must contain family name & relationship, a copy of covering letter mentioning travel plan with self introduction)

Relation Certificate and Marriage Certificate (Both Required)

Proof of Occupation

Self Employed – Cover letter on company letter head, company registration, partnership, proof of paid tax.

Employed – Work contract, letter from employer (no- objection) confirming leave period & returning back to work, copy of staff id.

Student – Letter from school / College confirming your studies, holiday or leave given to you, copy of Student ID.

Retired – Proof of Retirement / Pension book.

Detailed day to day itinerary.

Evidence of Financial Status

Self-Employed: Last 6 months Personal and Business Bank Statements & Property Valuation.

Student & Unemployed: Last 6 months Bank Statement of parents or legal guardian.

Retired: Personal pension bank statement for last 6 months. Proof of regular income generated by ownership of property or business & Property Valuation.

Insurance minimum coverage of 30000 Euros.

Flight Reservation

Round Trip Flight Booking.

If applicable (Proof of Intra-Schengen flight, Train Itinerary or Car rental.)

Visa & Entry Requirements

Do Nepali citizens need a visa for Europe?

Yes. You'll need a Schengen Visa to visit most European countries.



Which countries are covered by the Schengen Visa?

26 countries including France, Germany, Italy, Spain, Switzerland, and more.

Where do I apply for the visa?

Through VFS Global (Thamel, Kathmandu). Choose the embassy of the country you'll spend the most time in.

How long does visa processing take?

Typically 3–9 working days, but apply at least 1 month in advance

Flights & Travel Tips

Which airlines fly from Nepal to Europe?

Qatar Airways, Turkish Airlines, Emirates, and others via Middle Eastern hubs.

Can I travel between countries freely?

Yes, once inside the Schengen Area, you can move between member countries without border checks.

Can I extend my tourist visa while in Europe?

No, tourist visas cannot be extended while traveling.

What currency is used?

Most countries use the Euro (€), but some (like Switzerland) use their own.

What should I pack?

Warm clothes (Europe can be chilly even in spring)

Power adapter (Europe uses Type C/E/F plugs)

Travel documents + copies

Snacks and Nepali essentials (masala, wai-wai if you miss home!)

Is travel insurance mandatory?

Yes, and it must cover medical emergencies up to €30,000

Do people speak English?

Yes, especially in tourist areas. But learning basic phrases in French, German, or Italian can be helpful.

Are Nepali foods available?

In major cities like London, Paris, and Berlin, yes! You'll find Nepali restaurants and South Asian groceries.
